A Message from the Manager

As we start 2024 it is important to thank the volunteers that help run the community. It is important that the community have these volunteers to help run, govern and support The Westwood Club lifestyle. A very popular addition to the facility has been the new pickleball courts. These recently opened to very little fanfare but plenty of use. Yes, lights will be installed in the future depending upon budgetary constraints. There have been questions about how to reserve the pickleball courts. The rules on reservations mirror the tennis courts. The front desk keeps a list of reservations. Each time slot is 90 minutes in length. A household is allowed to reserve one court during a two-week window. Once you have used your reservation the window resets. Guests are permitted when accompanied by a resident. There currently is a \$3 fee or one punch on your guest pass. As a general point of information, the Club currently owns and rents out a pickleball machine. If you are looking for lessons you can contact our Pro- Ray Smith by text at 858.472.2286.

If you use the facility in the evenings, you may have noticed a recent upgrade to the lights on the exterior of the quad area. This project was done in conjunction with the mansard siding upgrade and was funded with reserve funds. Each year a portion of the annual dues are placed in a separate account to replace the capital items at the facility. The amount is determined in part by an outside consultant and is then reviewed and incorporated by the Board into the annual budget. The Board is currently looking at using a portion of these funds for slurry sealing the upper and lower parking lots and the trimming of the large pine trees on the property.

As we approach warmer weather the facility will become more crowded. As a staff member, we ask that you exercise courtesy towards all that enter our gates and remember to bring your ID cards each time you come to the Club.


