FAQs

Do I have to make a reservation to use the pool or fitness center?

Yes. This serves as part of our safe reopening plan by limiting the number of members in a space at any given time. It also gives us the ability to assist the County if we need to provide a list of users for contact tracing. Generally, this has gone well, and your cooperation has been outstanding.

What is open?

Currently the swimming pool, weight room, miniature golf and outdoor recreations areas are open to members of the same households and may require reservations. The Preschool is also open and operating. Please call 858-485-6300 for more information.

Will the Westwood Club be a polling location this year?

No. We were recently contacted by the registrar's office. They thanked the community for their previous participation and informed us they will not be using the Club as a polling location this election. They hope to resume use in the future. When will the Saunas and Spa re-open?

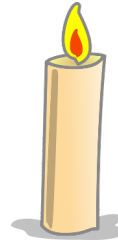
Much of our current operations are mandated by State and County limitations. Please refer to the tier system to answer that question. This is known as "A Blue Print For a Safer Economy". We are currently in the Red section two levels away from the lowest tier, "Yellow", which carries minimum risk. We will keep you up to date with new openings added to our website, constant contact and Facebook page as they are made available.

Is the ARC Committee still meeting to approve applications?

Yes. The committee will continue to meet on a Zoom Platform the first and third Wednesday of each month. Business will be conducted as normal. Due to the difficulty in remote meetings you are asked to have your ARC request to the office no later than the Friday prior to the meeting.

LUMINARIES

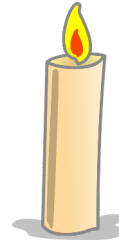
Luminaries will be sold in the upper parking lot of The Westwood Club on the following dates and times:

Information from the Architectural Committee

This has been a very busy year for the ARC. With many of us cancelling travel plans, coupled with attractive refinance rates there has been an incredible influx of ARC Review Applications. Here are some ways you can assist in making sure your application is not delayed. Please remember that the ARC consists of a dedicated group of volunteers. They are scheduled to meet the first and third Wednesday of each month. Currently due to Covid-19 restrictions they are only able to meet on a Zoom platform, thus there may be a delay in receiving a signed approval letter. We ask you schedule your projects and contractors appropriately.

For the committee to properly review an application in a timely manner it is helpful that they receive it prior to the Friday before the meeting. If you are painting your home, the manufactures color chip with name and code number is required. This allows each member to view it online. It also provides a lasting record in the file. When you submit an application for a photovoltaic solar system, a roof plan showing the layout of panels needs to be attached to your application. Roofing projects require a color brochure and a list of the materials to be used. Any supporting documents that will show the color and type of materials to be used on a project is helpful. Lastly, when revamping your landscape, a drawing showing the proposed changes and a listing of the replacement plants needs to be submitted. Be sure to consider the mature size of trees and plants. These few small suggestions will help streamline your application process.

New Year's Eve 12/31 - open 8am-4pm

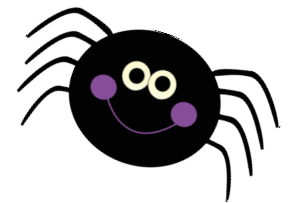
