Camp days are filled with games, crafts, swimming, and a variety of fun summertime activities. The camp program takes advantage of the club's amenities, ie the gymnasium, pool, fields, rooms and miniature golf. Weeks 2-7 will go on a field trips traveling by school bus. Details and permission slip on the field trip are passed out on the Monday of camp. Campers will need a lunch, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen and shoes suitable for running games. A snack will be served after swim time. Campers will have an opportunity to buy snacks at the teen center during lunch. Campers may bring money to purchase snacks and/or lunch.

CIT (counselor in Training) program available for 13 and 14 year olds. Pre-approval required prior to registration. This program is designed for campers that have aged out of the standard program. CITs will have the opportunity to participate in all camp activities as well as use the teen center. Cost for this program is \$160 per week.
